Statement Reminder: Why Do I Have \$0 to Spend?

The enclosed statement may show \$0 available to spend from your fund. The Foundation started a new fiscal year on July 1 and the new fiscal year available to spend amounts will be calculated in late July. Those amounts will appear on your September statement or you may call our office after August 1 for that amount. For Donor Advised or non-endowed funds, remember that available to spend is simply a calculation of a recommended spending balance, but Foundation policy allows you to make larger grants if desired as long as the minimum fund balance is maintained.

HCF Awards Grants

For the fifth time in three years, Heartland Community Foundation has awarded grants in Ellis, Rooks and Trego Counties. Over 60 applications totaling \$517,527 were received during the application period which ran from April 1 to May 15; 43 grants totaling \$147,933 were awarded. Funding for the grants was made possible by dollars from the Dane G. Hansen Foundation Fund for Heartland, the Heartland Action Fund, & the Kansas Health Foundation Fund. Grant recipients include:
