## **Operator of Intent**

Prior to division orders, operator relays intent to oil/gas purchaser of assigned interest

## **Transfer**

On an existing well, owner contacts purchaser and authorizes transfer of assigned interest

## Value of the Gift is Realized

The gift is deposited into the charitable fund requested by the owner
